Students of Suitela will now not only have access to three excellent personal trainers, (Adrian Crowe, Sean Reid and Jason Zappone), if they are on the competition team, they will also be able to participate in group fitness classes designed specifically to improve their athletic capabilities for both striking and grappling, rather than your regular bodybuilding training."

f.i.l.e.s.: "What are you doing now?"

Starnes: I am back teaching and training full time, I work out twice a day six days a week, and I teach both group classes and private lessons.

f.i.l.e.s.: "What are you looking to do in the future?" Starnes: "I'm looking to compete again this year several times, and my last fight was in November of 2008 in Hawaii against Chris Cisneros. I'm looking at Bellator Fighting Championships, which is a new promotion on ESPN as well as Sengoku, Dream and Affliction. I'm also looking into the movie business, and trying to spend more time writing."

f.i.l.e.s.: "What keeps you going?"

Starnes: "My family, my friends and my students. Everything that I am, I owe to other

people, most of whom I've never met, from the food that I eat, to the language that I speak. That makes me want to give something back, and gets me up in the morning."
