 SSG Wagner began his volunteer service with the organization known as "PROJECT PRAYER FLAG" in 2005. For the 3-year period 22MAR2007 to 21MAR2010, he devoted approximately 180 hours per year (letter from Shawn Black, Founder, dated 23MAR2010). SSG Wagner was instrumental in providing materials and military liaison communication to hundreds of soldiers. His direct efforts in Research and Development with the organization's support and administrative programs were exceptional. In 2009, SSG Wagner was honored for his volunteer service (unpaid) and "tireless work", for Project Prayer Flag, with an invitation to the Presidential Oval Office, and a personal meeting with then President George W. Bush. President Bush recognized Wagner for training California National Guard troops in various combat skills as well as supplying materials. SSG Wagner completed honorable, valued, volunteer service in the CA SMR for three (3) consecutive years (TY 06-10).
